





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At Matt Johnson Music Studio, Students Learn Musical Skills For A Lifetime

He is Cooper City's eminent musician, a composer of original works and an innovative teacher. Matt Johnson has been giving plano lessons since 1977, but his musical journey started much earlier.

"Growing up listening to my father play the piano peaked my musical interest," he said. "He taught me several pieces and then I began formal piano lessons when I was six years old. After 10 years of musical studies, I began teaching my friends and family and I've been teaching ever since."

Johnson trained as a classical planist and has won many awards as a performer. He made the transition to composing his own pieces and performing them in various venues including large concert halls, jazz clubs and soirées. From his studio in Cooper City, FL, he now uses the new technology to make his work available as CD recordings, and also as written scores available as pdf files. His music is also available on his YouTube channel.



Johnson teaches plano, theory, composition and the art of music notation or engraving, beginning with students as young as six years old. Giving students musical skills and understanding allows them to learn and play any kind of music. To this end, Johnson teaches students not only to read the written notational language of music, but also chordal and rhythmic understanding in the literature.

"Additionally, after learning to play the score exactly as written, I teach students how to supplement the music by adding notes and changing up the rhythms," he said. "With these goals in mind, I embrace the traditional Classical literature, but am also inclusive of other styles as well such as Pop, Jazz, Gospel, etc. Students are encouraged to bring in pieces they want to learn, thus sharing in the ownership of the literature selected for study."

Johnson enjoys working with beginners as much as advanced students.

"While each student's preferred learning style is embraced and utilized, focus is also given to the development and combination of a variety of learning characteristics, as further aids to learn and play more musically," he said. "My global educational goal for my students is to teach and empower them to learn for themselves. I aim to create new masters, musicians that are knowledgeable and functional, rather than simple Followers who are forever dependent on musical assistance."

Students are expected to practice daily to hone the skills that will be most beneficial through their lifetimes. Johnson's musical skills and experience also help students to see the bigger musical picture and the real world applications of their music.

My parents sought out Matt for lessons after they heard him play several church Christmas programs and were very impressed with his use of dynamics and how emotional his playing was. During our initial interview, he explained his philosophy of teaching his students to be thinking, performing and functional musicians, not just key pushers. He stressed the importance of looking past the written music and making it your own.

Matt's method is to have students learn to play a piece just as it is written first. Then after he is satisfied that they understand the piece as it was written and can play it that way, he works with them to instill techniques to make the music their own and add their personal style to the piece through improvisation. He teaches his students how to apply what they have learned about theory to improvise, change keys, reharmonize chord progressions, add arpeggios, implement various rhythms, carefully use dynamics and voicing, etc.

One of the most valuable things Matt taught me was to 'fill in' areas of a song where there are rests. When the music leaves one hand resting for two or three beats, improvise and fill in that dead space with some notes! This is where a fuller sound comes from. All of this makes the music more modern sounding, fuller and more rewarding because you are creating your own personalized version of the song—the way you like it.

His teaching style brought back the challenge, the joy, the sense of accomplishment and satisfaction. I didn't even know these were the things I was missing at the time.

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TEACHING PHILOSOPHY

My teaching philosophy and educational goals for my music students has evolved considerably since I began in 1977. While each student's preferred learning style is embraced and utilized—i.e., visual, auditory or kinesthetic—focus is also given to the development and combination of a variety of learning characteristics, as further aids to learn and play more musically.

My global educational goal for my students is to teach and empower them to learn for themselves. I aim to create new Masters—musicians that are knowledgeable and functional—rather than simple Followers who are forever dependent on musical assistance.

I believe it is important that students not only learn to read the written notational language of music, but also that they not be limited by it. Therefore, I teach chordal and rhythmic understanding in whatever literature we're working on. Additionally, after learning to play the score exactly as written, I teach students how to supplement the music by adding notes and changing up the rhythms.

With these goals in mind, I embrace the traditional Classical literature, but am also inclusive of other styles as well—i.e., Popular, Jazz, Gospel, etc. Students are encouraged to bring in pieces they want to learn, thus sharing in the ownership of the literature selected for study.

I teach **piano**, **composition**, **theory** and the art of **music notation/engraving**. 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



Eventually, seeing and thinking the chords will lead to a greater ability to do "fills"...then secondary melodic lines...and, eventually much more comfort to "improvise" on top of the written notes.

TEACHING OLDER ADULTS

Students who fall into the more "mature" category have a special opportunity to finally learn to play the piano and play the songs they want to learn.

Many parents and grandparents of younger students say, "I wish I hadn't stopped lessons when I was a kid" or "I've always wanted to learn to play." Thankfully, learning to play the piano is not an age-related skill.

TEACHING PHILOSOPHY

My teaching philosophy and educational goals for my music students has evolved considerably since I began in 1977. While each student's preferred learning style is embraced and utilized—i.e., visual, auditory or kinesthetic—focus is also given to the development and combination of a variety of learning characteristics, as further aids to learn and play more musically.

My global educational goal for my students is to teach and empower them to learn for themselves. I aim to create new Masters-musicians that are knowledgeable and functional-rather than simple Followers who are forever dependent on musical assistance.

I believe it is important that students not only learn to read the written notational language of music, but also that they not be limited by it. Therefore, I teach chordal and rhythmic understanding in whatever literature we're working on. Additionally, after learning to play the score exactly as written, I teach students how to supplement the music by adding notes and changing up the rhythms.

With these goals in mind, I embrace the traditional Classical literature, but am also inclusive of other styles as well-i.e., Popular, Jazz, Gospel, etc. Students are encouraged to bring in pieces they want to learn, thus sharing in the ownership of the literature selected for study.

I teach piano, composition, theory and the art of music notation/ engraving. While I enjoy working with my advanced students, I also delight in introducing beginners to the joys of musical study. A multiple-key approach for beginning students is my preference, but I often utilize the traditional middle-C method books as well. In order to develop artistic and expressive performance skills, students are expected to practice daily-spending as much time as is necessary to conquer their weekly musical goals and assignments. Since most students are involved with multiple extracurricular activitiesand sufficient practice time is hard to come by-they are introduced to the concept of clearly defined and deliberate practice in order to meet their short and long term goals. While the skill will be developed and honed within a musical context, it should prove most beneficial throughout the student's lifetime.

By gifting students with musical skills and understanding, they learn how to learn any music they want, thus providing a lifetime of enjoyment in making music.

Matt Johnson is a dynamic, classically trained pianist who received his Bachelor of Music degree in Piano Performance from Oklahoma Baptist University. As a graduate student at New England Conservatory of Music, he formally expanded his talents in the area of composition. Studying under William Thomas McKinley, he received his Master of Music degree in Jazz Studies and Composition with a Distinction in Performance.

A prolific writer and performer, Matt has performed extensively in venues from Boston to Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. His music is Neo-Romantic, employing a unique blend of contemporary jazz, new age, popular and classical elements.

He teaches his students how to apply what they have learned about theory to improvise, change keys, reharmonize chord progressions, add arpeggios, implement various rhythms, carefully use dynamics and voicing, etc. One of the most valuable things Matt taught me was to 'fill in' areas of a song where there are rests. When the music leaves one hand resting for two or three beats, improvise and fill in that dead space with some notes! This is where a fuller sound comes from. All of this makes the music more modern sounding, fuller and more rewarding because you are creating your own personalized version of the song-the way you like it.
